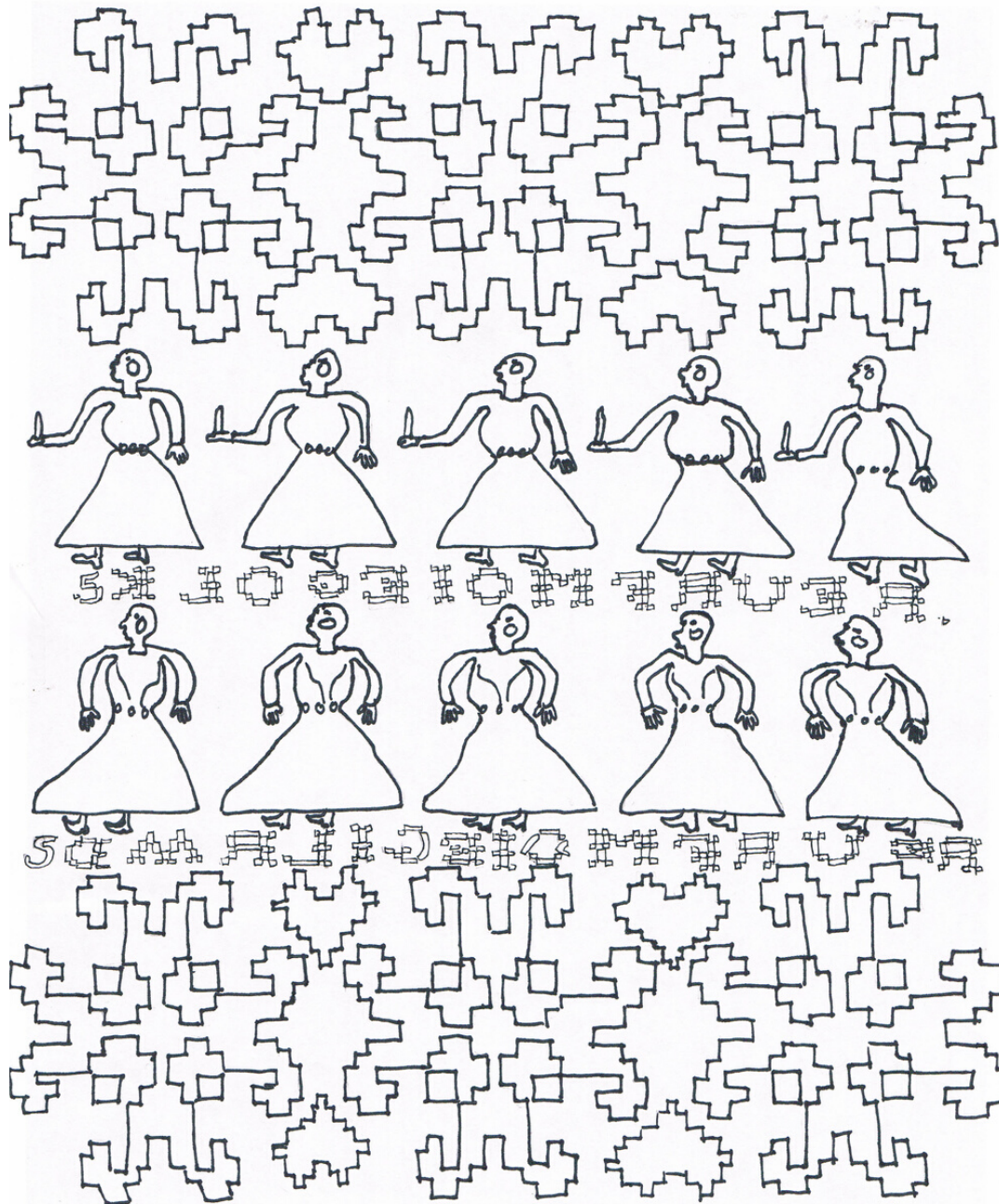


# Colour the Collection

This Swedish tapestry portrays the parable of "The Wise and Foolish Virgins." The parable tells of ten virgins waiting for a bridegroom, five with oil for their lamps and five without. When the bridegroom arrives the five virgins with no oil have to go get some. When they return the door is closed and they are rejected. The parable teaches to be prepared as the bridegroom represents the second coming of Christ.
